July 17, 1924 - September 20, 2014

Bernard Arseneault, son of Jean-Baptist Arseneault and Adeline Richard was born July 17, 1924 in St Isidore, New Brunswick, Canada, died September 20, 2014 in Warren Michigan, USA, with his family at his side. He is survived by his wife Agnes, daughter of Eucher Thomas and Flavie Comeau. They were married 66 years.

Along with his family, he worked as a lumberjack in New Brunswick and spent 13 months in the Canadian Army in 1944-45. A well-known face at St Clement Church, he was in the Usher's Club, Dad's Club, and involved in various other volunteer activities.

He was one of the first Board Members establishing Father Murray's Credit Union. His children all attended St Clement School. For the last five years, he spent much of his time at home with his wife, who had suffered a mild stroke. He was well-loved by all and will always remain in the hearts of all he touched.
