He also cared about clean water, healthy (organic) food; being prepared for the long term and air quality. He is a man who spoke up/posted in order to make the world a better place for all of us. Dale wanted to be cremated and have his ashes combined with his beloved wife, Deborah (White) Williams’ ashes and spread at Island Lake in MI and some ashes at a special, private location at a ranch in Colorado and some of their remains will be incorporated into handmade legacy lampwork glass, along with pictures of Debi’s art, that will be created by Sheila Morley.
