Earlo Lloyd Harris of Warren, MI, age 71, passed away on May 24, 2022. He was born on December 18, 1950, in New Eagle, PA. Son of the late Earlo and Betty (Lancaster) Harris of Ellsworth, PA (where he grew up). Earlo graduated in 1969 from Bentworth High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army and served his country in the Vietnam War as an E-5 soldier and was honorably discharged in 1971. Just before he went to Vietnam, he married his wife Connie (Amos). When he returned home after his one-year tour, they moved to Copperas Cove, TX where he would finish his time in the Army. Eventually, they moved to Warren, MI where they would raise a family. Earl worked at Jones and Laughlin Steel Mill, Chrysler Corp, and Eastown Distributers where he retired.
